01

02

The question will have 8 option choices, with #1 being the most popular choice and #8 being the least

03

Send in a player from your team

04

The players will try and hit the buzzer first to try and get the #1 answer first


05

Team with the #1 answer gets control of the board, and remaining team members answer one by one to fill in remaining spots on the board

06

If the controlling team gets three strikes, the opposing team now has one chance to get all the points by getting one answer

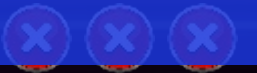
